A gold and garnet pendant, circa 1830, mounted with an oval carbuncle garnet within a surround of foil backed flat cut garnets, length 3cm.

Condition Report

542. This piece possibly started life as a brooch and has been later converted for wear as a pendant. There are some lead solder repair marks visible at the back holding the centre into position. There are a few dents at the back. The surrounding foil backed flat cut garnets have some variation of cut and one looks to be a replacement due to the octagonal table facet and side facets. The central carbuncle garnet and its setting also look to be later added. Weight 5g.
