A gold, amethyst and seed pearl pendant of scrolling foliate form, claw set with an oval cut amethyst and a pear shaped amethyst drop, otherwise set with seed pearls, length 5.5cm, on a gold neckchain with a boltring clasp, detailed '14k', length 45.5cm, with a case.

Condition Report

568. The amethysts are of medium to pale colour saturation, with some variation of colour and a few internal inclusions. Some claws are missing from the central amethyst and it looks as though every alternate claw is missing. The claws to the drop are intact. The seed pearls are an attractive white colour. The piece is unmarked. The centre of the back has the screw threaded fitting where a brooch pin for alternative wear would have been fitted in the past. Suggested age ♦ Edwardian. The gold neckchain is fairly modern.

Chain ♦ weight 0.7g.

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
