An early 19th century brooch of curved rectangular form, glazed with a central hair locket compartment within a floral surround, width 2.5cm, a similar smaller brooch, width 1.8cm, and a gold, seed pearl and blue paste set brooch, width 2.4cm.

Condition Report

596. Brooch One ♦ replacement hair work to the central glazed locket compartment. The hinged bracelet at the back is a later replacement, with evidence of the previous hinge visible behind this. Otherwise good condition.

Brooch Two ♦ the front is in good condition. The back hook to secure the pin is replaced, the pin is also replaced and there is some corrosion by the hinge pin.

Brooch Three ♦ seed pearls are of attractive silvery colour. There are slight surface marks to some of the blue pastes, one corner blue paste is a replacement. The back of the brooch is in good condition. They would all benefit from careful professional cleaning.

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
