LOT 606

A Victorian gold brooch of shaped oval form with applied bead and wirework decoration in a classical design, width 3.5cm, a gold mounted shaped oval brooch, glazed with a woven hair locket compartment within a scrolled surround, width 2.5cm, and a Victorian gilt metal shaped oval brooch with two leaf motifs, width 4.5cm.

Condition Report

606. Brooch One ♦ some small pieces of applied gold wirework are now missing. Two to three dents to the centre of the brooch. The glazing and locket compartment frame are missing from the back. Visible at the back is the diamond shaped registration mark. Circa 1880.

Brooch Two ♦ the front is in good condition. The locket compartment has very slight insignificant surface marks. There is a split behind the brooch pin where the central back panel meets the front of the brooch. The hook and fitting to the hook are later base metal replacements. The back of the brooch where four script initials are engraved is dented. Circa 1850.

Brooch Three ♦ circa 1880 but is gold plated. There is wear to base metal on the high points. Old test mark down to base metal at the back, the locket compartment frame and glazing is missing from the back.

1st two brooches only ♦ weight 4.2g and 4.7g.

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
