## LOT 612

A Victorian gold and carbuncle garnet set pendant brooch, circa 1870, mounted with three carbuncle garnets to the top enclosing a trefoil leaf motif, the front fitted with a foliate capped carbuncle garnet drop, the back glazed with an oval locket compartment, width 3.5cm, length 5.5cm.

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## Condition Report

612. The principal garnet has an internal surface reaching inclusion. The other three garnets have one or two insignificant surface marks. The circular suspension loop at the top is probably a later addition. There is slight tarnishing to the gold work, which would be regarded as an attractive patina. There are no hallmarks to the piece, although not tested by us it is probably approximately 15ct gold. The glazed locket compartment appears to be sealed and would need to be opened by a professional jeweller. It is currently glazed with a textile interior. Otherwise overall good condition. Weight 20.6g.
