A gold cased keywind open-faced lady's fob watch, the skeletonized movement with a cylinder escapement, detailed 'Muret Geneve', gilt metal inner case, the signed gilt dial with black Roman numerals, the case exterior with engraved and engine turned decoration, detailed '18K', case diameter 3.6cm, with a key, together with a 9ct gold cased keyless wind open-faced lady's fob watch with cylinder movement, gold inner case, the decorated gilt dial with black Roman numerals, import mark London 1908, case diameter 3.3cm.

1037. Keywind watch, marked 18K - winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently running but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Case in generally good clean condition with only a couple of minor dents, typical light surface wear and scratches. Inner case and case back hinges are good and close tightly. Dial is good, perhaps a little dirty. Total weight 34.1g.

9ct keyless wind watch - winds and adjusts, and is currently running but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Some small dents to case back and sides, inner case and case back are both quite thin, but hinges are good and they close tightly. Inner case with 9ct hallmark. No inscription and misshapen/dented. Dial is good and clean. Total weight 26.8g.

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
