### LOT 1160

An early 19th century mahogany drop dial wall timepiece with brass four pillar chain driven single fusee movement, the repainted 10-inch convex dial with black Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'AlexR Cumming, London', with cast brass bezel and convex glass, the moulded circular surround above a chisel bottomed apron with hinged door, case diameter 29cm, height 38cm, with pendulum.

Estimate: £400 - £600

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### Condition Report

1160. The dial has been repainted, otherwise the clock is in generally good original condition. Convex glass bezel and hinge in good order. Case with typical light wear, scuffs, nicks and scratches, but no significant damage or repairs.
