A French Louis Philippe rosewood cased mantel clock, the eight day movement with silk suspension, striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the backplate signed 'Berthet & Bazelaire a Paris', the similarly signed silvered dial with black Roman hour numerals, the rectangular case and plinth base with line inlay and boxwood banding, on turned feet, height 33.2cm, with pendulum and winding key.

Condition Report

1173. Clock is in generally good condition with typical light surface scratches and wear. Case is a little faded in colour in places but no significant damage or repairs. Typical wear to brass bezel and some typical wear to silvering of dial and makers signature. The movement winds smoothly and currently runs and strikes but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
