An early 19th century brass inlaid mahogany octagonal cased wall timepiece with eight day single fusee movement, the 10-inch painted circular convex dial with black Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'French Royal Exchange London', the octagonal case inlaid with panels of brass foliate scrolls, case width 37.5cm, with pendulum and case key.

Condition Report

1230. Generally good, but restored condition. Re-painted dial and replacement hinges and locks to doors. Movement looks to be in good order. Case with no damage, but with the restoration there has obviously been some repairs dealt with.

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
