A Royal Crown Derby 1128 Imari pattern two handled vase and cover, late 20th century, with integral cover and gilded handles, red printed factory mark to base, height 30cm.

Condition Report

1496. The vase is in three sections united by a metal rod which tightens at the base. The bone china is in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Only very light surface scratches to gilt and no significant wear. The rod probably needs a little tightening as they are at present ever so slightly loose with very minor movement between each piece. 1st quality.
