A Chinese famille rose porcelain hat stand table lamp, late Qing dynasty, of quatrelobed outline with four pierced apertures, painted with scenes of warriors in a landscape, height 28cm, with gilt metal table lamp fittings and wood base.

Estimate: £350 - £450

Condition Report

1155. Porcelain body appears to be in good condition with no obvious damage or repairs. Typical minor wear to enamels and gilt. Due to the mounts it is obvious that the piece must have a drill hole through the base for it to be wired. Unfortunately the mounts to top and bottom do not remove easily, so we are unable to give any guarantee to the condition of the rim, however there is nothing apparent that would suggest damage or repair.
