A Chinese parcel gilt and brown patinated bronze bottle vase, Qing dynasty, probably 18th century, the narrow neck applied with an entwined chilong, the globular body with cast leaf shaped panels within engraved floral borders, unmarked, height 16.6cm.

Condition Report

1002. Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical surface wear to gilt particularly on high points and typical surface scratches. Couple of very minor shallow dents to body and a small copper dot repair(?) to body, but not obviously noticeable.
