### LOT 1058

A Chinese famille verte porcelain circular bowl, Kangxi period, with gently everted rim, the exterior painted with opposing panels of Buddhist lions, flanked by fan shaped panels of fish reserved against a green ground of dense flowers and foliage, the interior with lotus beneath a floral rim reserved with panels of crustacea, enamelled artemisia leaf mark to base, diameter 17.8cm (minor restored chip, minor hairline and chips to rim).

### Condition Report

1058. Approx 8mm long narrow chip to rim exterior above lion panel which has been visibly and poorly filled, alongside is a smaller nibbled chip which has a branched 2.5cm long vertical haircrack running from it. In addition there is a narrow 1cm long spot of fritting to the rim above the same panel. Otherwise in good condition. Enamels strong with no real signs of wear.
