A pair of Chinese power blue glazed porcelain ginger jars and covers, Kangxi style but 19th century, decorated in gilt with pagodas on islands beneath a border of floral panels, unmarked, height 24cm (decoration rubbed, faults to both covers).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1075. Bot jars are fundamentally in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs, although the gilt decoration on both is worn and rubbed to varying degrees. One cover has been broken into five pieces and visibly riveted with minor losses along the break lines. The other cover is broken into twelve pieces with signs of old rivet and glued repairs - all the pieces seem to be present apart from some minor losses along the break lines.
