A pair of Chinese famille verte enameled porcelain jars and a cover, Qing dynasty, each ovoid body painted with three arched panels of flowers and rocks within iron red chrysanthemum and scroll borders, possibly later decorated, heights 21.2cm and 18cm (minor chips and one with small hairline to rim).

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

1242. First vase - lacking cover. Three chips to footrim. Minute nick to inner rim edge of neck. Very light and minor surface wear to enamels.

Second vase - cover broken into a number of pieces and extensively and visibly restored. Large almost circular firing crack to base visible when inverted. Three chips to footrim. Extensive chipping and vertical haircrack to neck rim. Enamels good with only very light wear.
