An Art Nouveau gold, opal and diamond pendant necklace in a scrolling design, collet set with a central oval opal and a collet set oval opal drop, otherwise mounted with circular cut diamonds, on a fine link neckchain with a three stone division, length from division 6cm, length of chain 41.5cm.

Condition Report

515. Unmarked, gold backed and silver set. The opals have a varied but subtle play of colour. The diamonds are attractive white stones with one or two internal inclusions. The three stone motif above the principal pendant is perhaps a later alteration. There would originally have been a screw in brooch pin fitting which is now lacking. Otherwise an attractive piece. The neckchain can be detached from the top of the pendant. Suggested age circa 1900.

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
