A set of twelve late Victorian silver fish knives and forks with silver ferrules and ivory handles, Sheffield 1898 and 1899 by Allen & Darwin, cased.

Condition Report

403. All handles have typical light surface scratches and wear to crests. A few crests more worn than others. Case has typical wear and scratches. Escutcheon is loose. Interior is a bit tired. One knife handle with small split to each side. Otherwise blades in good condition with good clear hallmarks. Each fork handle is good with no splits, typical light surface scratches and wear. Good clear hallmarks. One handle has 'blown' and silver has pushed out slightly making the ferrule loose so would need attention. The handle however is in good condition.
