A Chinese ring-formed trinket/necklace basket, late Qing dynasty, finely worked to the base and cover with ventilated cash trellis bands, embellished with eight Buddhist infinity knots, diameter 19cm, containing a single row necklace of one hundred and eight translucent amber spherical beads, length 141cm.

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

1101. Basket is finely woven and is generally in good condition. One of the applied infinity knots to the top and one to the base have slightly unravelled in places, otherwise the work is in very good order. Hinge is good and clasp is good.

Amber bead necklace in generally good order with only typical light surface scratches and wear but no significant damage or repairs.
