A pair of George V silver oval sweetmeat baskets, each cast and pierced with foliate scrolling decoration, on an oval foot, London 1913 by D. & J. Wellby Ltd, height 10.5cm.

Condition Report

310. Generally speaking they are in good condition except that both have been pushed down slightly onto the base, so they do not sit quite straight. Otherwise the piercing and casting is in good crisp order with only very little typical light surface wear and typical light scratches. Hallmarks are good and clear. Both stems have been pushed down slightly into the bases, but no other damage such as splits or creases, presumably because they are cast rather than if they were the thinner embossed type. Nice quality - total weight 777g.
