A George III silver oval swing handled sugar bowl, engraved with foliate borders, London 1800 by Solomon Hougham, height 15cm, and an Irish silver two-handled sugar bowl, raised on paw feet, Dublin 1814 by James Le Bas, height 11cm.

Condition Report

350. Swing handle bowl - large dent to one side of the body and few other small dents to body, otherwise a bit dirty but in ok condition with no repairs or splits. Engraving is good. Good clear hallmarks.

Two-handled bowl - generally good condition, no significant damage or repairs. Good engraving. Few very minor dents to body, but of no real significance. Marks readable, but slightly indistinct.
