A Chinese famille rose porcelain saucer dish, mark of Chenghua but late Qing dynasty, painted with three iron red bats, framed by a border of three auspicious fruit branches divided by three gilt characters, iron red enamelled four-character mark to base, diameter 14cm, together with a Chinese famille rose provincial porcelain dish, diameter 17.5cm, and a porcelain octagonal dish, painted with warriors, width 21cm.

Condition Report

1196. Saucer dish - 1cm long vertical hairline to rim, gilt rim rubbed, otherwise ok.

Provincial dish - small chip to footrim, tiny manufacturing blemish to rim edge, some staking wear to enamels.

Octagonal dish - surface scratches, otherwise ok.
