A Chinese 'clobbered' blue and white Kraak porcelain double-gourd bottle vase, Wanli period, the lower bulb with three panels painted with groupings of auspicious Buddhistic emblems alternating with flowers, the upper bulb with panels of flowers alternating with precious objects on stands, later embellished in iron red, pink, green, yellow and gilt, clobbered iron red seal mark to base, height 30cm (rivet repair to neck).

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

1085. Starcrack to lower bulb just above foot, running horizontally approx 15cm and vertically approx 8cm running into further branches across base underside. Some crazing to glaze overall. The neck has been completely broken off in one large and a few smaller pieces and visibly riveted with minor filled restoration. Fritting to neck rim circumference. Otherwise typical light wear overall and rubbed gilding.
