A pair of Chinese Canton famille rose vases, mid to late 19th century, each ovoid body and flared neck painted and gilt with figural panels within borders of butterflies, flowers, bat and precious objects, each neck applied with gilt Buddhistic lion and cub handles above applied gilt chilong to shoulders, height 44cm (one repaired), with wood stands (damaged).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1036. First - chilong to one shoulder is missing a little part of its back, really inconsequential. Otherwise in good condition overall with no chips, cracks or repairs.

Second - body overall extensively broken into a number of large and small pieces and well glued together with museum style restoration. All the pieces are present, apart from a small section approx 3cm x 1cm to side of one figural panel and some chipping to the underside rim edge. Both wood stands have damage losses and repairs.
