A pair of Chinese Canton famille rose porcelain vases, late 19th century, each slender baluster body with flared neck, painted with figural and foliate panels against a gilt ground filled with flowers, tendrils and butterflies, flanked by moulded gilt mask and ring handles, height 25.5cm (one repaired), with two wood stands, together with a Chinese crackle glazed porcelain circular bowl, painted with dragons and vapours, diameter 25cm.

Condition Report

1037. Vase 1 - approx 3cm section of rim repaired, hairline to neck, wear to gilt handles, minor wear to enamels.

Vase 2 - wear to gilt handles and to enamels, insignificant chip to underside of base.

Dish - typical wear to the interior, otherwise ok.
