Condition Report

2130. One has later repairs to the rear seat rail/back joint with a chip to one side. Also some woodworm to two seat rails.

The other has a crack to the top of one rear leg and just a few dots of worm to the seat rails. Otherwise minor scuffs, marks and bumps overall.
