An 18th century and later walnut lowboy, the moulded top above three drawers and a shaped apron, raised on carved cabriole legs and pad feet, height 73cm, width 76cm, depth 47cm (alterations).

Condition Report

2014. The main elements of the lowboy are right, however, the understructure, including drawer rails and supporting screws seem to be later. The drawers seem to be fine and the carving to the legs seem genuine. There is a small crack to the edge of the top but otherwise the condition is quite good with only some light scuffs and marks.
