A pair of Chinese jadeite panels, 20th century, each of fan shape, applied with hardstones forming displays of peonies beneath white magnolias, each supported within a carved and pierced hardwood stand applied with carved bone roses, total height 41cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

1038. Panel 1 - generally good condition, some minor chips and scuffs to the rock crystal rocks near base of panel, otherwise the other hardstones appear in good order.

Panel 2 - has two hairline inclusions which essentially run the entire length of the panel, only really noticeable from reverse. Some minor nicks and scuffs to rock crystal rocks near base of panel, one of the cream coloured flowers to the left of panel has broken in two and been re-glued with some signs of glue residue visible. The reverse has sellotape stuck along the hairlines, probably where the vendor feared it might break.

Both stands are in generally good sound condition. Minor chips to flowerhead petals.
