A pair of late Victorian silver pipe rests, each end raised on two tapering and ball feet, Birmingham 1900 by Henry Matthews, length 9cm, together with a silver mounted globular glass match strike, London 1901, height 5.3cm, a silver circular ashtray, Birmingham 1907, length 9.7cm, and a silver rectangular cigarette case, London 1955, length 10.3cm.

Condition Report

344. Both pipe rests in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches. Good clear hallmarks. Total weight for both 40.5g.

Glass matchstrike is in generally good order, glass is not cracked or badly scratched but does have numerous minor chips to ribbing. Silver with minor dents, knocks to rim but no significant damage. Good clear hallmarks. Cigarette case - good condition, inner hinged holder is bent and misshapen. Weight 166g.

Ashtry - dented and misshapen. Weight 75.8g.
