A Chinese small pale celadon jade wine or water cup, Qing dynasty, possibly 18th century, carved as a wicker-work rice measure, the exterior with simulated rushwork, the stone of greenish/grey tone, height 2.6cm.

1014. Good condition, no significant cracks or repairs. There is a hairline inclusion to the rim which runs halfway down the body into the black inclusion in the stone, otherwise carving is good.
