A Chinese famille verte yellow ground porcelain vase and cover, late 19th century, the shouldered tapering body painted with bats surmounting opposing panels of warriors and performers before a dignitary, surrounded by lotus scrolls and flowers, unmarked, height 27cm (restored), together with a Chinese blue and white crackle glazed vase with iron oxide borders, height 44.5cm (repaired), six Chinese turquoise ground porcelain bowls, four Japanese blue and white chargers and two vases.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1063. Yellow ground vase - rim is restored, otherwise body in good order. Cover is also restored.

Large blue and white vase - large section of neck is broken and glued. Body also with numerous cracks.

Small blue and white vase - chip to rim and chips around footrim.

Small blue and white pot - cracked.

Six turquoise ground bowls - one chipped, each with varying degrees of wear and scratches to interior but otherwise good condition with no cracks or repairs.

All four Japanese blue and white dishes - no chips, cracks or repairs, typical light surface scratches and wear.
