## LOT 2065

An early 20th century Italian ebony collector's cabinet-on-stand, inlaid with overall celluloid panels engraved with figures, animals, landscape scenes and floral fruit sprays, fitted with a pair of doors enclosing eight drawers and a central cupboard, the stand with a single frieze drawer, raised on square tapering legs united by a shaped 'X' stretcher, height 135cm, width 70cm, depth 40cm (some faults).

## Condition Report

2065. Numerous pieces of stringing and veneer loss with some pieces retained, but quite a number missing. Three ring handles missing. Overall surface wear to ebonizing as well as some movement to the carcass on left side top panel and base, causing the veneer to split. Some other small pieces of veneer missing to corners.
