A 17th/18th century Continental walnut side cabinet, the moulded top above two drawers and four panelled doors, flanked by barley twist supports, the stepped base on later turned feet, height 144cm, width 155cm, depth 65cm (alterations).

Condition Report

2055. The majority of the piece is genuinely old and probably late 17th/early 18th century. The rear legs are later and the rear panels have been re-attached a couple of times, with later screw holes to the edges. The brass key escutcheons are later and there is overall historic woodworm throughout parts of the cabinet.
