A pair of Ashby Guild stoneware vases, 1909-22, the swollen cylindrical bodies with everted rims and spreading feet, both covered in a streaked blue glaze over a dark green ground, impressed mark to bases, heights 29.5cm and 30cm.

Condition Report

Both with overall fine crazing to the glaze. One has small filled glaze chip (probably since manufacture) to edge of foot and 2 other small glaze chips to edge of foot. The other vase similarly has one small glaze chip to the edge of the foot.
