A pair of Minton porcelain chinoiserie style boxes and covers, circa 1870, designed by Christopher Dresser, of square shape, decorated with a turquoise ground panel to each face and raised on integral pseudo hardwood stands, unmarked, height 7.5cm (one cover broken in two, faults).

Condition Report

4155. First - vertical crack running length of one corner of main box, some crazing to glaze overall, cover heavily crazed and broken in two diagonally with losses to one corner.

Second - crazing primarily visible to turquoise panels, branched starcrack visible primarily to interior over two faces and base. Cover ok.
