## LOT 4149

A large Della Robbia Pottery two-handled vase, circa 1900, probably designed by Charles Collis, decorated by Lizzie Wilkins, the high-shouldered body with tall stems of Art Nouveau tulips in shades of green against a blue ground, flanked by green glazed loop handles, incised and painted marks to base with numerals '846', height 30.5cm (glued repair to neck rim and with lampbase fitting).

## Condition Report

The neck of the vase has a glued lamp base fitting inserted into it - this is a wooden disc which has been drilled to accommodate a cable, the vase itself has therefore not been drilled. A 2.5 by 2cm chip has been broken away from the rim by one of the handles and is visibly glued back into position, there are some minor glaze losses along the break line. Otherwise the vase is in good overall condition with typical crazing to the glaze and some minor spots of glaze flaking. Towards the base of the vase there is some green glaze missing from a few of the leafy stems - this is a manufacturing issue and not damage.
