A Della Robbia Pottery bottle vase, circa 1900, painted with flowering stems of geranium against green oval panels and a darker green ground, with onion shaped gullet type swelling to the neck, incised and painted marks to base with monogram 'ELL' and black painted cypher, height 35cm (repaired neck).

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

Broken in two beneath swollen part of neck and visibly glued with some minor losses along break line. Overall typical crazing to the glaze. 2cm long by 1cm wide flat chip to exterior edge of foot. Some fritting and glaze loss to top rim edge of neck which has some cork glued to its interior - the remains of some kind of lamp fitting, the vase has not been drilled.
