A Linthorpe Pottery collapsed rim vase, circa 1880, with green and yellow running glaze to the exterior, brown glazed interior, unmarked, height 7cm, together with a Linthorpe vase, decorated with pine, height 8cm (restored), and another art pottery vase, height 19cm. Note: a similar collapsed rim vase from Christopher Dresser's own collection is illustrated in 'Christopher Dresser' by Widar Halén, plate 188.

Estimate: £60 - £90

Condition Report

Collapsed rim vase - typical overall crazing to glaze and two small chips to upper rim edge, two chips to footrim.

Pine decorated vase - approx two thirds of rim professionally but visibly restored due to matt appearance, with a visible glued repair to remaining part of rim. Glaze typically crazed with overall surface blemishes.

Vase - typical overall fine crazing to glaze, otherwise in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Some very minor and indistinct light surface scratches.
