A Spanish maiolica mortar, Teruel, 17th century, the U-shaped body covered in a white glaze above a solid unglazed circular foot, relief decorated to the exterior with three vertical ribs and decorated with green splodges and manganese dashes, the rim with pouring lip, unmarked, height 11.2cm (faults).

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

1412. Overall crazing to glaze with some glaze loss to base interior. Approx 4cm long vertical crack to rim. 2cm long by 1cm wide chip to rim to left of spout and other small flat chips/glaze loss to rim circumference and vertical relief struts to exterior, with glaze bruise between two of the struts. Minor chips to foot.
