A pair of Bow porcelain figures, circa 1760, modelled as an elegant lady and gentleman standing beside flowering bocage, he with a basket of fruit, she with a basket of flowers, on scroll moulded bases with turquoise enamel and gilt detail, remains of candelabra fittings to reverse of bases, red painted anchor and dagger mark to each base, height 25cm (some faults and restoration).

1407. Male - professional restoration to neck with associated clear spraying to torso/arms. Missing trailing end of hat ribbon. Typical small chips and losses to relief applied flowers and foliage.

Female - typical small chips/losses to relief applied flowers and foliage, otherwise in good condition. No restoration.
