A Royal Worcester porcelain potpourri vase, liner and cover, circa 1910, the bulbous body painted by Jas Stinton, signed, with a male and female pheasant above a moulded gilt enriched lower body, flanked by blush ivory angular and foliate handles beneath the pierced neck and domed cover, puce printed mark to base with shape No. '1995', height 18.5cm (cover restored).

Estimate: £150 - £200

Condition Report

1448. The cover has been broken at least in two and is noticeably and extensively restored.

The liner has some insignificant nicks to the underside rim edge.

The vase has a minor nick to the leafy terminal of one handle, and the gilded details of the handles and neck is worn/rubbed to varying degrees, otherwise the vase is OK with no restoration.
