A late George III silver rectangular castle top snuff box, the hinged lid decorated in relief with a scene of Windsor Castle within a foliate surround, the hinged lid interior presentation inscribed, London 1819, probably by William Ellerby, length 8.9cm.

Condition Report

410. The box is generally in excellent condition commensurate with age. Typical light surface wear but relief decoration is very crisp. Hinge is good. Few nicks to edges and a very minor dent to one side. Good clear hallmarks. Engraved inscription to lid interior. Weight 154g.
