### LOT 573

A gold ring, mounted with an oval cut garnet between two oval opals with two pairs of rose cut diamonds at intervals, the mount detailed '18', ring size approx S, and a gold, opal and stained green agate set five shank harem ring, ring size approx Q.

Estimate: £100 - £150

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### Condition Report

573. Opal and garnet ring - the claws have been replaced in the past and the central garnet is perhaps a replacement for a previously missing opal. One of the remaining opals which has some surface wear is more likely to be original to the ring having more wear than the other, the other opal also has a chip when viewed from the back. The shank is a little thin at the back. Typical light surface scratches, wear and abrasions, but no significant damage or repairs. Weight 4.4g.

Opal and green agate ring - there are one or two surface marks to one of the opals. There is slight variation of colour to the opals, two or three of these have probably been replaced in the past. Otherwise the ring is in fairly good condition, typical light wear and scratches but no significant damage or repairs. The ring has two marks when viewed from the front 'GT' and '14'. Weight 17.1g.

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
