A diamond, cultured pearl and ruby brooch, designed as a beetle, mounted with rose cut diamonds and half-pearls with cabochon ruby set eyes, the back glazed with a locket compartment, length 4.5cm, with a case (some rose cut diamonds lacking).

608. One half-pearl is a little raised from its setting, is peeling at one end and looks to be a replacement. The side claws of the beetle are slightly bent inwards. One antenna at the front of the beetle appears to be showing down to brass, this is visible from the back. Weight 11.8g.
