A gold and diamond ring, collet set with a pear shaped diamond within a surround of rose cut diamonds between split 'V' shoulders, the shank with engraved decoration, ring size approx Q, with a case.

Condition Report

610. There is a chip to the side of the principal diamond at 3 o'clock, the diamond otherwise looks to be a fairly clear stone, the setting is possibly hiding further chips at around 8 and 9 o'clock. The surrounding diamonds are a combination of mostly old cut cushion shaped diamonds, with one rose diamond, the settings to these are rather rubbed. Suggested age 20th Century in a late 19th Century inspired design. Weight 4.5g.
