A Worcester porcelain teapot and cover, circa 1768, the globular body painted in the Mandarin style with Chinese figures in a landscape setting, accompanied by a dog, the cover with floral finial, unmarked, height 13cm. Note: a similarly decorated teapot and cover is illustrated by Simon Spero and John Sandon in 'Worcester Porcelain 1751-1790, The Zorensky Collection', p.366. Here it explains the colour palette and border suggest decoration of this type was probably executed outside the Worcester factory.

1404. Minor professional restoration to finial of cover - only really noticeable with UV light. Gilt rims typically rubbed with a few insignificant scratches to enamels, otherwise in good condition.
