A stoneware gilt metal mounted table oil lamp, probably Doulton, late 19th century, decorated in the Aesthetic style with panels of birds and foliage above a globular body decorated with flowers against a textured ground, raised on a gilt metal base with scroll supports cast with lion masks, the reservoir fitted with a Hinks burner, height 47cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1446. In good condition overall with no chips, cracks or repairs. The only part of the pottery which can be seen from the underside is the top of the glass reservoir beneath the mechanism, and when the reservoir is inverted you can see this part of the pottery is crazed and stained, but this is not noticeable to the exterior. Mechanism appears to be working, but please note we do not offer guarantees to working order or reliability. No chimney or shade.
