Condition Report

1431. Saucer - in good condition overall, no chips, cracks or restoration. Light rubbing to gilding.
Cup - in good condition overall, no chips, cracks or restoration. Gilding typically rubbed primarily to extremities with light surface scratches and a few minor spots of loss to gilded interior.
