A Minton's set of six coffee cups and saucers, early 20th century, decorated in turquoise enamelling and gilt with a dotted band to the rim, suspended with garlands, puce printed and iron red painted marks to bases, height of cups 5.2cm, held within a fitted case.

### Condition Report

1455. Saucers - one with fine hairline to rim, otherwise all in good condition with no chips, cracks or restoration.

Cups - two have indistinct horizontal hairline running from lower handle terminal, otherwise all in good condition with no chips, cracks or restoration.

Case - typically scuffed, marked and stained to interior. Missing one clasp.
