A 19th century French comtoise or morbier wall clock with eight day movement striking on a gong, the circular enamel dial inscribed 'H. Gody à Thonars', the brass surround embossed with flowers, height 42.5cm, with brass embossed pendulum and two weights.

Estimate: £60 - £80

Condition Report

1173. The clock has been fully restored.

The brass case and pendulum has some misshaping and repairs and with what looks like a new shiny lacquer finish.

Dial is ok with minor loss but no significant damage.

Iron weights are not particularly good with some pitting to sides.
