A Derby porcelain soup tureen and cover and pair of matching sauce tureens, covers and stands, circa 1825-30, painted with floral panels against a gilt decorated cobalt blue ground, the handles with lion mask terminals above paw feet, red painted marks to bases (some faults and restoration).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1497. Soup tureen - overall fine crazing to glaze with very light staining. 2.5cm long vertical haircrack to middle of rim on one side. Small area of restoration to side of one gilt foot. Typical wear to gilding, particularly on extremities.

Sauce tureen stands - both typically crazed with light staining and some rubbing/wear to gilding.

Sauce tureens - both typically crazed with light staining and typical rubbing/wear to gilding, in addition one has three breaks with restoration to one handle.

Sauce tureen covers - one extensively broken and professionally restored, the other with long crack running its length and associated small chip.
